RULES OF THE NEEDS ASSISTANCE FUND

- The intent of this fund is to allow participation in the 2016 Hood County Livestock Show and Sale. The applicant must be eligible to participate in the show in order to be considered.
- The maximum amount loaned will be \$300.00 for the purchase of the project and a maximum of \$300.00 for feed if needed for animal projects.
- The following projects are eligible for funding: Sheep, Swine, Goats, Poultry, Rabbits, and Family Living.
- The purchase of projects will be funded directly to the seller with NO funds passing through the hands of the applicant or a family member of the applicant.
- A feed contract will be made with a local merchant so that feed may be picked up as needed by the applicant if the loan includes feed cost.
- Expenses not covered by this fund include but are not limited to following: Pen construction cost, Equipment cost, Entry fees, Validation fees, and Fitting fees.
- Projects can not be purchased from family members.

- Family living projects expenses will be funded directly to the supplier.
- The project must be brought to the 2016 Show and may be sold on the floor if it does not make the Sale.
- The unpaid amount of the loan will be withheld from any proceeds due the applicant from the premium or floor sale. The full repayment of the loan shall occur within seven days after receipt of the 2016 checks from the Hood County Livestock Raisers Association.
- No interest will be charged for the loan if repaid as agreed.
- Each applicant will only be allowed one loan per show year.
- The project will be under the direction of a FFA or 4-H advisor.
